It was a lot of fun seeing so many at the last Club meeting as well as last weekend's Indy Cylinder Head show. That show is always a great social gathering as well as a nice time to hunt down all the cool car junk we just have to get our hands on!!

KELLY BROTHERS- THE FORMATIVE YEARS - by Tom Kelly

Well, at last month's meeting, Club President Evan Springer started off with an interesting topic, something along the line of 'what started us out as Mopar fanatics?' This has been a pleasant diversion for me lately to keep my mind on something pleasant so I thought about the early years (it does not really seem as long as it's been) back to the time when a first car ended up as my obsession.

Per my mom I was fascinated by cars as a child; she helped me put my first model car together at 6 so she takes part of the blame. Fast forward to growing up in Clermont on Raceway Road (West County Line back then) and watching the race cars roll into the US Nationals every Labor Day starting in 1961 when I was 9 years old. They were being towed, and traffic was 'stop and go' past the house back then so we'd admire all those gorgeous race cars from our front yard and tree house.

I could not wait to get a car so worked as a kid baling hay saving my money and eventually at 15, got on at Indianapolis Raceway Park cutting grass, painting and general grounds keeping. We got to work during the Nationals delivering water to the timing towers, fixing up pit fences or anything else called upon to do. What better environment to get car crazy... I was there to experience the 1968 Hemi Darts and Cudas when they first hit the drag strip!

My older cousin sold Chrysler automobiles to my dad & family since before I could remember so by this time, just watching the Max Wedge and Hemi race cars dominate on the drag strip had already steered me to a passion for Mopars. In 1963 & 64, the Indiana State Police had 'blue and white' 2 door sedan Plymouths for their cruisers so by the time I got my license in 1968, they were now on the used car lots around Indy.

Unfortunately, my wallet did not seem to match my desire, not much different than today. \$650-850 dollars for a 383 police 2 door was a heck of a deal but if you only had \$400 saved, you were out of luck. So instead, I found a nice little Slant 6, three speed on the column 1962 Plymouth 4 door. The '62s still have the face only a mother would love but I love them even today (I have a two door sedan now at home on a rotisserie).

Well the Slant 6 did get me around for a good year or so but 'not quite fast enough'... I still don't know how I pulled this off but back then \$500 was a lot of money. Though not sure how she did it, I talked my mom into loaning me that much for a 383 and 4 speed trans from a rolled over 1968 Road Runner from Wrecks, Inc., the largest late model junk yard in Indy. With the help of a large oak tree, a chain fall, my brothers and cousin who owned a body shop and welded, my cardboard templates became the most horrible set of motor mounts and monstrosity of an automobile you ever saw. But it got me and the younger Kelly boys on the road.
