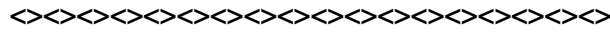


much as I used to once the 'Cuda was completed. My wife, Karen, likes to drive it. She doesn't like to drive the 'Cuda though - it scares her!

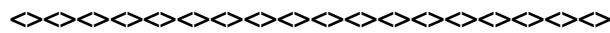
In 1973, she moved from Detroit to Farwell and then in 1999 she became a resident of Monroe. She was a member of St. Michael Catholic Church.
